

Class 3 – Summer 2

Maths	Our focuses this term will be decimals including money, shape and statistics, with a strong focus on number.
English	<p>Miss Harris's group will be studying the picture book, Flotsam, this half term. We will focus on writing for a range of purposes: character descriptions, persuasive 'eBay' adverts and a story.</p> <p>Mrs. Mahoney's group will be focusing on sentence structure using a range of images, alongside recounts.</p> <p>The whole class will also be writing non-chronological reports about rivers.</p> <p>Our first class book is 'Otherland' by Louie Stowell, and the children will vote over another one!</p>
Science	Our science this term will focus on 'states of matter', including the water cycle.
PSHE	We will be covering unit on 'Economic Safety', this half-term. Furthermore, we are focussing on dealing with change, and friendship skills.
Religious Education	This term, we are continuing to study Sikhism, answering the key question: What does it mean to be a Sikh in Britain today?
PE	We will be doing dance and athletics in PE this term.
Computing	<p>This term, we will be focussing on in internet safety lessons is 'Manging Online Reputation'.</p> <p>We will also be looking at data and information, alongside using the Ozobots in programming.</p>
History	Our key question this term is: How do Rivers Change from Source to Sea?
French	In French, we will be learning about 'Sport'.
Music	We will continue to learn to play our mini-trumpets, alongside learning to read music.
